Choose as Input cover hidro_andalucia.shp

Change the "Proyección_Destino" to EPSG: 4326

Save the reproject in a temporary file

Click Ok

Click cancel button in the new pop up window (This pop up has a fast expire, then hurry up to click cancel button to stop the process)
