Steps

- 1.- Open gvSIG
- 2.- Open TABLE
- 3.- Open concejos.navarra.dbf (<http://downloads.gvsig.org/download/geodata/tables/DBF/>)
- 4.- Select a field
- 5.- Go to Menu Table/Rename Column
- 6.- Rename column and the information disappears

Si renombras un campo de tipo string (Iniciar Edición de la tabla, seleccionar campo toponimia\_e y clic en el botón renombrar campo), por el nombre toponimia\_esp. En primer lugar aparece un error, pero modifica el nombre del campo por toponimia\_esp. Si intentas modificar una segunda vez el nombre del campo, toponimia\_esp, por otro nombre, borra todos los registros del campo y cierra la edición guardando cambios.

Si renombras un campo de tipo integer, concejos por ejemplo, modifica el nombre del campo y cierra automáticamente la edición, guardando cambios.
