Create a new view  
Add layer ([http://downloads.gvsig.org/download/geodata/vector/DGN/Albarracin1\\_SITAR\\_DGN.zip](http://downloads.gvsig.org/download/geodata/vector/DGN/Albarracin1_SITAR_DGN.zip))  
Right click on name layer in ToC, start edition  
Delete one element  
Right click on name layer in ToC, finish edition  
Click Save  
A warning message appears:
