I have a attributive table named "1" join to a table imported from CSV extension named "2".  
This table join named "1-2" has been joined to a second table imported from CSV extension named "3".

**so finally I have a table named "1-2-3"**

My problem is I have an error message : "*Semantic error in expression null*" when I search a value in the list frm a field of table "3".  
with the filter command, if I choose a field from table 1 with the operator equal I have a result, but if I choose a field from table "2" or "3" in the table "1-2-3", I have the previous message.

Is it because table "2" and "3" come from CSV file so are not attributive tables of a shape ?
