#### Description

The graphical scale in the layout doesn't allow an intermediate interval. The format allowed is INTEGER+ZEROS (for example 1000, 500, 2000, 3000, 10000...), but not INTEGER+INTEGER+ZEROS (for example 2500, 25000...).

For example, if we write the interval 25000 it changes to 20000 or 30000, and if we write 2500 it changes to 2000 or 3000.
