1. create more than one view;
2. load a raster layer in a whatever view you like and activate it;
3. try to execute a whatever raster geoprocess from the toolbox (gvSIG geoprocess --> Raster layers)
4. finally, a warning message appears saying that *"This tool needs a raster layer selected in the view"*
