Hi Alvaro,

if we use the "Export to" tool and choose a specific format (e.g. Shape file), when we have to specify the exported file name, the Open dialog uses the "All supported" file filter, so it shows all the files (with their related extension, e.g. .shp, .dbf, .shx, .prj, .tif, etc.) available in the target folder. Instead, as in the ticket description, it should filter **only** the .shp extension. So I reopen the ticket, because the bug (or the feature request, if you want) is still valid. Thanks for your attention.
