Description			
<p>Testing the <i>gvSIG-desktop-2.3.0-2404-devel-win-x86_64-online.jar</i> installer, I have found that BusyBox crashes when gvSIG.sh is executed. The reason seems to be explained in the CLI:</p> <p>gvSIG.sh: trap: line 38: ERR: invalid signal specification</p> <p>But substituting ERR with e.g. SIGALRM, it crashes the same. Instead, commenting line 184:</p> <p>#setPreferedArchitecture</p> <p>gvSIG.sh is executed without any apparent problems.</p>
