### Description

I've seen that when a project depends on `_fwAndami` it does from the project itself, not from the compiled library. It is so in all cases apart from `extHelp`, `extQuickInfo` and `extProjectBackup` where there is a mix between jar and project dependences.

Attached a patch which changes those dependences to the standard in gvSIG 1.X: andami dependence as project, not as jar.
