**Description**

Working on a lot of layers, in different projections, I wanted to move some vertexes of a layer that had been reprojected (on the fly).

The layer can be put in editing mode (and deleting of features works), edit vertex tool could be selected, but then feature could not be edited (the vertex numbers don't even appear).

I suppose that such layers are not editable by technical choice, but in that case it is mandatory to inform the user the reason. Also it should not be possible to put those layers in editing mode.
