#### Description

It is hard to load CSVs that lack an initial header row. The attached CSV has been generated using LibreOffice Calc 4.2.8.2 using default CSV saving options. It can only be loaded using the Advanced properties tab, manually specifying the header field.

It would be better to generate some default headers (e.g. F1, F2, F3, F4, F5, etc) when it's not possible to generate a header from existing data.
