But if I double-click e.g. on a text file in the Scripting composer, a StackOverflowError occurs with a terrifying untranslated message: "Error de la aplicacion. Es conveniente que salga de la aplicación"

I think that this issue is not very easy to replicate. In fact, if I have a scripting home folder with only few scripts, I can open, edit and save text files (e.g. .txt, .inf., .properties, etc.) without problem. Instead, if I use the scripting home folder with all my testing scripts, the error occurs. I have to exclude some of them in order to isolate which one causes the issue. In the meanwhile I attach the gvsig.log.
