<p>Sometimes If I try to execute win64 gvSIG portable double-clicking on the gvsig-desktop.vbs file, the following error appears:</p> <p>vbs_error.png</p> <p>The error is due to the second row of gvsig-desktop.vbs:</p> <pre>shell.CurrentDirectory = "\${INSTALL_PATH}"</pre> <p>In fact, <code>\${INSTALL_PATH}</code> doesn't exist on Windows.
