Description

The installer asks for the language to use, English or Spanish.
If I choose english the installer llooks ok, but the add-ons installer (launched in a separated process and window) appears with "translation labels" : they contain underscores and are all lower cased (see the image attached)
Also, because I have an italian locale, the buttons labels appear translated in italian (well, some captions should be translated better...).

This all is quite confusing to the user...
