Hello Andrea.

In gvSIG 2.3, we created a special gvSIG version for Ubuntu 16.04 because we had problems with the native versions of the version for "linux" in general.

With gvSIG 2.4 we have changed the criteria.

We have created a version for ubuntu 14.04 with the native ones for that version, and adapted the one of "linux" so that it works in ubuntu 16.04 and following.

From what I see in the log you should have installed the gvSIG version:

```
gvSIG-desktop-2.4.0-2827-testing-lin_ubuntu_14.04-x86_64-standard.run
```

For your system, "Ubuntu 16.04.2 LTS", the correct would be:

```
gvSIG-desktop-2.4.0-2827-testing-lin-x86_64-standard.run
```
