**Description**

*System.out.println* is ignored both in the console of the Scripting composer and the Jython console itself since gvSIG 1.12 at least. For instance, if I execute the following *helloWorld.py* script:

```
# encoding: utf-8

from java.lang import System

def main(*args):

    System.out.println("Hello world")
```

these are the log messages:

```
Running script helloWorld.
Script helloWorld terminated.
```
