Patching the HomeFolder class in folders.py in this way:

```
from java.lang import System

# ...

class HomeFolder(FolderNode):
    def __init__(self, parent):
        if System.getProperty("os.name").lower().startswith("win"):
            homeFolder = os.getenv("USERPROFILE")
        else:
            homeFolder = os.path.expanduser('~')
        FolderNode.__init__(self, parent,
            homeFolder,
            ToolsLocator.getI18nManager().getTranslation("_User_folder"),
            icon=getResource(__file__, "images", "Home.png")
        )
```

works pretty fine in Windows, even if other errors occur like the following:
