Instead, the "real" SEXTANTE help should be more detailed with description text and images. In reference to this issue I have investigated further and I found that SEXTANTE help files are put in a wrong path. The right path should be `es.unex.sextante\help\en**.xml`, as is in the sextante.zip nightly build file and I explained in this ticket.
